

RECORD OF ORDINANCES

Ordinance No. 1097

Passed September 17 1984

AN ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT THE PARKING OF SEMI-TRACTOR OR TRAILER ASSEMBLIES OR OTHER IMPEDIMENTS TO THE NORMAL FLOW OF TRAFFIC ON PUBLIC STREETS AND BY-WAYS WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF CROOKSVILLE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village of Crooksville is largely comprised of streets of narrow width which permit one side parking only with a difficult and restricted flow of traffic, and;

WHEREAS, the parking of semi-tractor or truck and trailer assemblies or any other large vehicles on these narrow streets creates an immediate danger to motorists and pedestrians and impedes the routine flow of traffic;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF CROOKSVILLE, OHIO:

Section One: PROHIBITION

The parking of semi-tractor or truck and trailer assemblies or any other vehicle large enough to impede the normal flow of traffic upon the Village streets or By-ways within the Village of Crooksville shall at all times be prohibited, unless the operator of such a vehicle found parked upon a Village street is then involved in the process of acquiring or delivering freight to or from a Village customer.

Section Two: PENALTY

Any person convicted of a violation of this Ordinance shall be fined a sum not to exceed \$100.00 for each violation thereof.

Section Three: EMERGENCY MEASURE

This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for preservation of the public peace, health and safety of said Village of Crooksville, Ohio, and shall become effective immediately.
